## By the Way...

The Texas Annual Conference begins the Sunday evening of Memorial Day weekend.

For those who don't understand the structure of our denomination, the term "annual conference" refers to a regional body and a yearly meeting. Geographically, the Texas Annual Conference stretches from Orange to Texarkana to Marlin to Lexington to Wharton. Basically, cut off the whole eastern part of Texas and that's us. Our conferences offices are located in Houston where the Methodist Building is filled with clergy and lay staff who are responsible for coordinating ministry and directing the business of the conference.

In the United States there are 56 annual conferences, overseen by bishops in 46 episcopal areas. There are 75 annual conferences in Africa, Europe, and the Philippines, which are supervised by 20 bishops. [An interesting note: our bishop is also the bishop over the United Methodist missions in Laos and Thailand until they grow into annual conferences.]

When we meet as the Texas Annual Conference each year there are to be an equal number of clergy members and lay members in attendance. We come together for three days to worship, enjoy fellowship, experience some learning opportunities, and conduct the business of the conference. The business sessions include reports of ongoing work; adoption of future goals, programs and budgets; ordination of clergy members as deacons and elders; and election of delegates to Jurisdictional and General Conferences (every 4 years). The bishop is the presiding officer over these meetings.

This year we are meeting at The Woodlands UMC and I will be there with our lay delegate, Kenneth Young. I want to thank him for stepping up to this

responsibility. He has never been before and is learning quickly how much information there is to take in and some of the logistics involved. Because he is your representative to the conference, please feel free to talk to Kenneth about any questions or issues that are important to you. He is soliciting your input.

Please be in prayer for our annual conference and the United Methodist Church as we continue to discern where God is leading us in sharing the grace and truth of Christ.
