By the Way...

Last month a woman in London spent three days trying to coax her pet parrot, Jessie, off the roof of her home. Finally, she called for help, first from an animal welfare agency and then from firefighters. When the London Fire Brigade arrived on the scene, Jessie shocked them by squawking an expletive at them.

Nonetheless, the crew manager volunteered to go up the ladder to try and bring Jessie down. He was told that to bond with the parrot he had to tell her “I love you.” Jessie responded back, “I love you.” Then Jessie unleashed her foul fowl mouth and she kept swearing at her rescuer.

After a few minutes interacting with the crew manager, the Macaw parrot flew off, first to another roof and then onto a tree. As you can imagine, the owner was embarrassed by her parrot’s conduct so she uploaded to Twitter a video of Jessie saying “Thank you” to the Fire Brigade.

How are you representing the Master? What would people parrot based on your example? Are you aware that people are watching what you do and listening to what you say and they are basing their attitudes about Jesus on it? Non-Christians carry around hypocrisy detectors so that when it goes off they have another reason to justify their unbelief. Very few non-Christians have well thought reasons for not believing; most non-Christians use anecdotal reasons.

We are called to be clothed with Christ (Galatians 3:27), witnesses for Christ (Acts 1:8), ambassadors of Christ (2 Corinthians 5:20), the light of Christ—Jesus says, “You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven” (Matthew 5:14-16).

Let the sacrifice of Jesus and the work of the Holy Spirit be evident in your life. Give them a bird’s-eye view of what God has done in your life and use your voice to share the good news.
